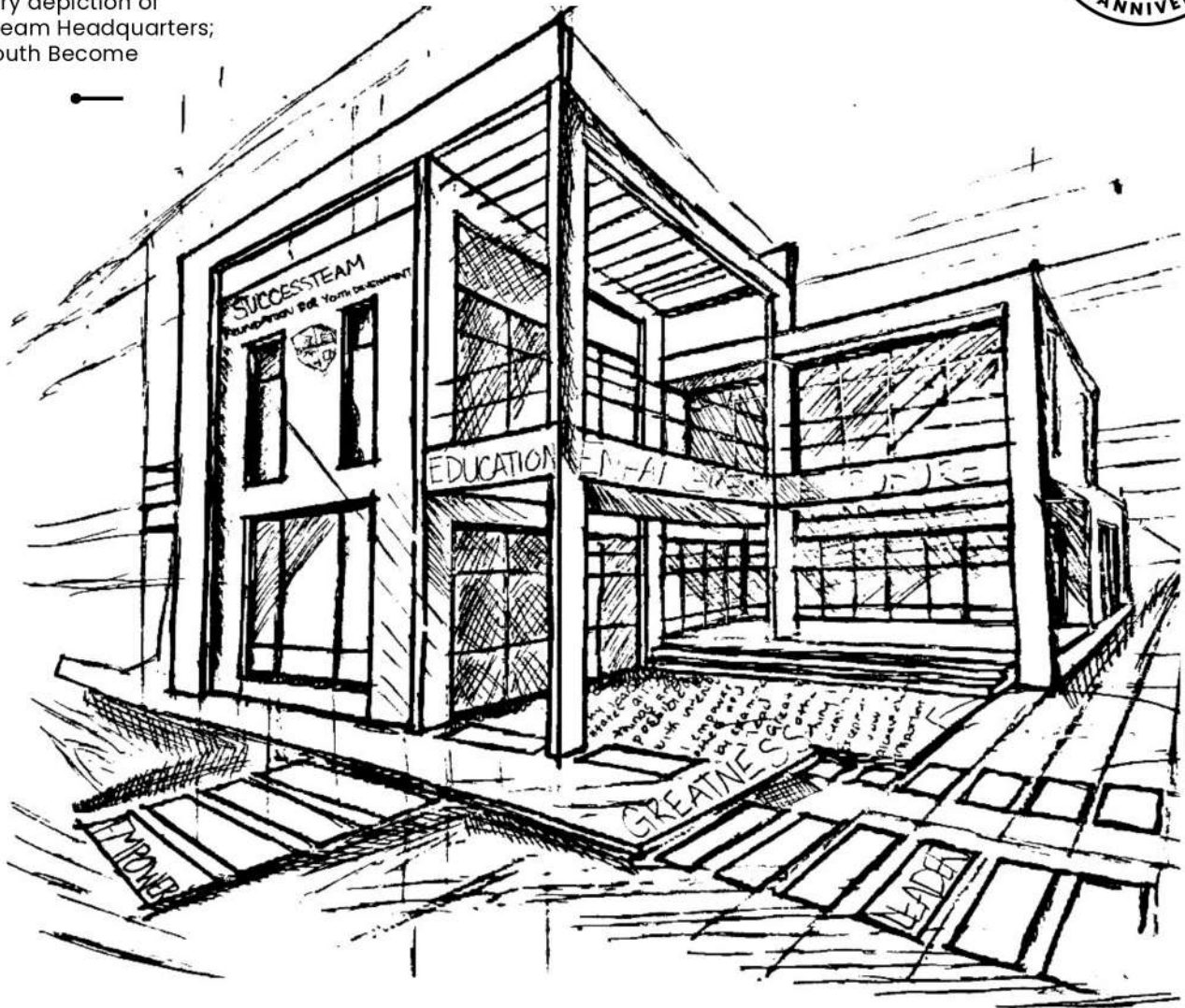

With intention to increase community engagement, Successteam begins the process of launching its new branding & marketing campaign including updated logos, organizational structure, and the introduction of unisex programming.

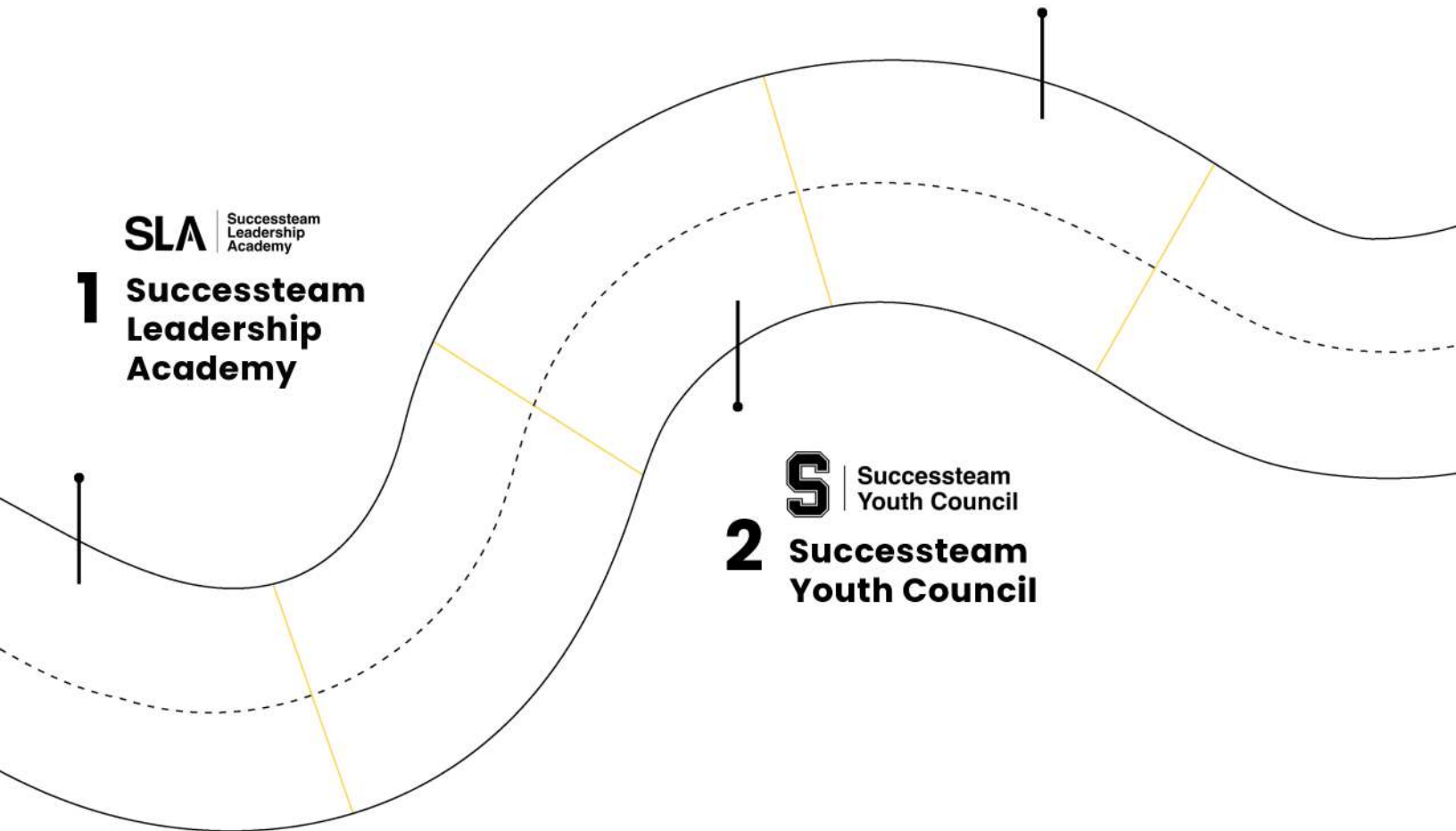

MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN THE LIVES OF OUR YOUTH

SuccessTeam provides a structured journey for students to grow as leaders. Starting with the SuccessTeam Leadership Academy (SLA), the membership orientation, students are introduced to the importance of the organization and the impact it can have on their growth. They then apply their knowledge in the SuccessTeam Youth Council, gaining hands-on experience through service and advocacy. Then graduates stay connected through the SuccessTeam Alumni Association, accessing career development, mentorship, and networking opportunities. This pathway ensures students are prepared for success in college, careers, and beyond.

Successteam Youth Council

Successteam Youth Council impacts high school students, grades 9th – 12th, via Leadership Development, College Readiness, Career & Workforce Development, and Community Service. Students become members and gain exclusive access to the annual Successteam Leadership Academy, biweekly mentoring sessions, college tours, certification classes, scholarship eligibility, volunteer hours, and multi-day overnight outreach experiences. Ultimately, Successteam Youth Council focuses on preparing aspiring leaders for their next-phase in life including 4 – Year University, 2 – Year Technical College, employment, entrepreneurship, or military.

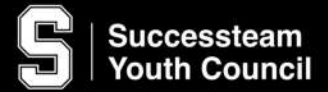

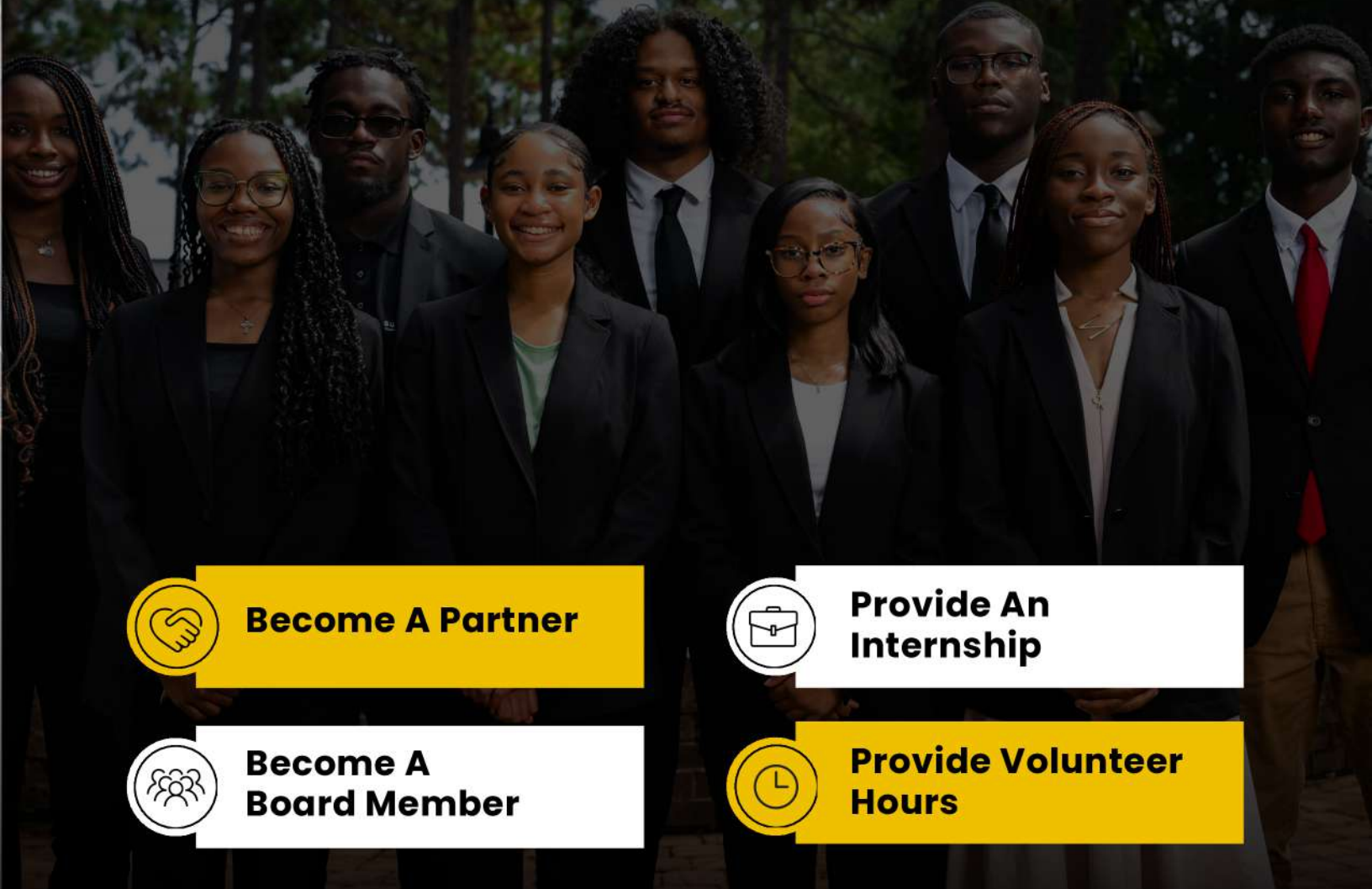
